The Student and the Student's parents had been advised on the charges against the Student in writing and had been advised of their due process rights. The student was provided with all due process rights required by law and District policy.

The Board has considered all of the evidence presented at the hearing and, based on the evidence, has reached the following conclusion: Student 11/18/13:WYN01 was guilty of Section IV.5, "Possession of a Weapon."

Therefore, it is resolved that Student 11/18/13:WYN01 is expelled from the Chippewa Valley School District from November 18, 2013 until the end of the academic school year 2013/2014. Student 11/18/13:WYN01 is prohibited from entering any premises owned, operated or controlled by the District or attending any District function. Ayes, all. Motion carried.
