  - ✓ Dakota High School Choir Fashion Show, November 5<sup>th</sup> which he will emcee; funds raised will offset students travel costs to National Festival of the States in Oahu, Hawaii
  - These observations during recent visits to schools: Ottawa Elementary has a successful Reading Challenge; Read 180 program at Chippewa Valley 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Center has improved student skills; Reading Exploratory classes at Seneca Middle School are selecting challenging books. Students reported being challenged by the Measure of Academic Process (MAP) assessments.
