### G.1 Approve New Board Policies #1411 & 4211/Whistleblower Protection Mr. Roberts

RECOMMENDED MOTION: "That the Chippewa Valley Schools Board of Education approve new board policies #1411 and #4211/Whistleblower Protection and that the reading of the policies be waived."

RATIONALE: These policies are provided in response to heightened attention to workplace issues, recent focus of audit inquiry, and in accordance with M.C.L.A. 15.36. The policies and administrative guidelines set forth procedures for the reporting of violations and protect employees from disciplinary action or retaliation for reporting violations in good faith. The policies also cover reports of violations by employees that do not involve criminal offenses and are not likely to cause an imminent risk of harm. These policies reflect the current state of law.
