<u>MOTION #03/13/16</u> – Moved by Member Cardamone and supported by Member Patzert that the Board of Education conducted a hearing on March 7, 2016, in a closed session concerning the Administration's recommended expulsion of Student 03/07/16:DHS01.

The Student and the Student's parents had been advised on the charges against the Student in writing, and had been advised of their due process rights. The Student was provided with all due process rights required by law and District policy.

The Board has considered all of the evidence presented at the hearing and, based on the evidence, reached the following conclusion: Student, 03/07/16:DHS01, was guilty of: Sections IV.39, "Gross Misbehavior."

Therefore, it is resolved that Student 03/07/16:DHS01, is expelled from the Chippewa Valley School District, from 03/07/2016, through 09/05/2016. Student, 03/07/16:DHS01, is prohibited from entering any premises owned, operated or controlled by the District or attending any District function for the duration of the expulsion. A roll call vote was taken. Member Aquino, yes; Member DeMuynck Zech, yes; Member Patzert, yes; Member Cardamone, yes; Member Pyden, yes; Member Bednard, yes. Motion carried.
