Chippewa Valley Public Schools

Three Macomb County public school districts were among 36 honored statewide by Munetrix Municipal Metrics for outstanding fiscal scores for three consecutive years.

Chippewa Valley Public Schools, Fraser Public Schools and Warren Woods Public Schools were among the districts recognized.

Chippewa Valley was the largest district, based upon enrollment, to receive the recognition.

Munetrix is a public sector solutions provider offering data management, analytics and reporting tools for states, local governments and public school districts. The perfect Munetrix Scores are for the 2016-17, 2015-16 and 2014-15 school years and are based on the latest available audited school district data provided by the Michigan Department of Education. The Munetrix Score range is zero to 10, with zero being a perfect score. Munetrix's algorithms mash 12 critical data points over three-years while looking for chronic or high magnitude problems such as a tenuous fund balance or large enrollment swings. The Munetrix Score provides school leaders a robust fiscal early warning tool and allows them the ability to model financial plans into the future to see what their "wellness" will look like two to three years down the road.
