The ASBDA is a national organization composed of professionally trained, experienced directors and teachers of school bands whose purpose is to advance and improve music education of those students engaged in the study of band instruments. There were 55 band directors selected for membership this year in the United States.

Directors are selected on the basis of their teaching experience, the success of their music programs and the recommendation of members of the organization. The association consists of approximately 500 band directors from the United States.

Through active participation in ASBDA, members share ideas, strategies, hear new music and attend clinics given by nationally known musicians, directors and clinicians.
