Nino Salvaggio International Marketplace in Clinton Township is teaming up with Detroit radio station WDVD-FM (96.3) to host a Stuff-A-Bus toy collection drive through the weekend.

The marketplace has a school bus on loan from Chippewa Valley Schools on the property for people to drop off new unwrapped toys. Once the bus is filled with presents, the toys will be distributed to various local charities.

“Our part of this program is to provide a central point for the bus,” said Fred Rayle, director of operations for Nino Salvaggio. “We want to help to make sure every child in metropolitan Detroit has a happy holiday this year.”

Organizers said the toys will be given to Beaumont Children’s Hospital, Orchards Children’s Services, Volunteers of America, Goodfellows, Bridgepoint and others. Staff members and volunteers will then distribute the gifts to children.

Kirk Taylor, president of Nino Salvaggio, said in a statement that he hopes the bus is so full “we’ll need eight reindeer or our own to help pull it down Hall Road.”

Donation hours are 6 a.m.-10 p.m. today; 9 a.m.-10 p.m. Saturday; and 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Sunday. Nino Salvaggio is located at 17496 Hall Road east of Garfield Road.
