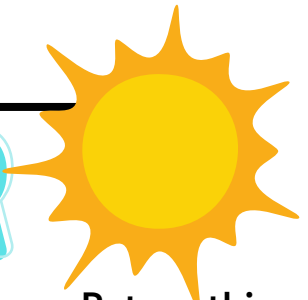
ALL students who participate (in any way) and return a signed form will receive a kid's meal coupon for Noodles & Company.

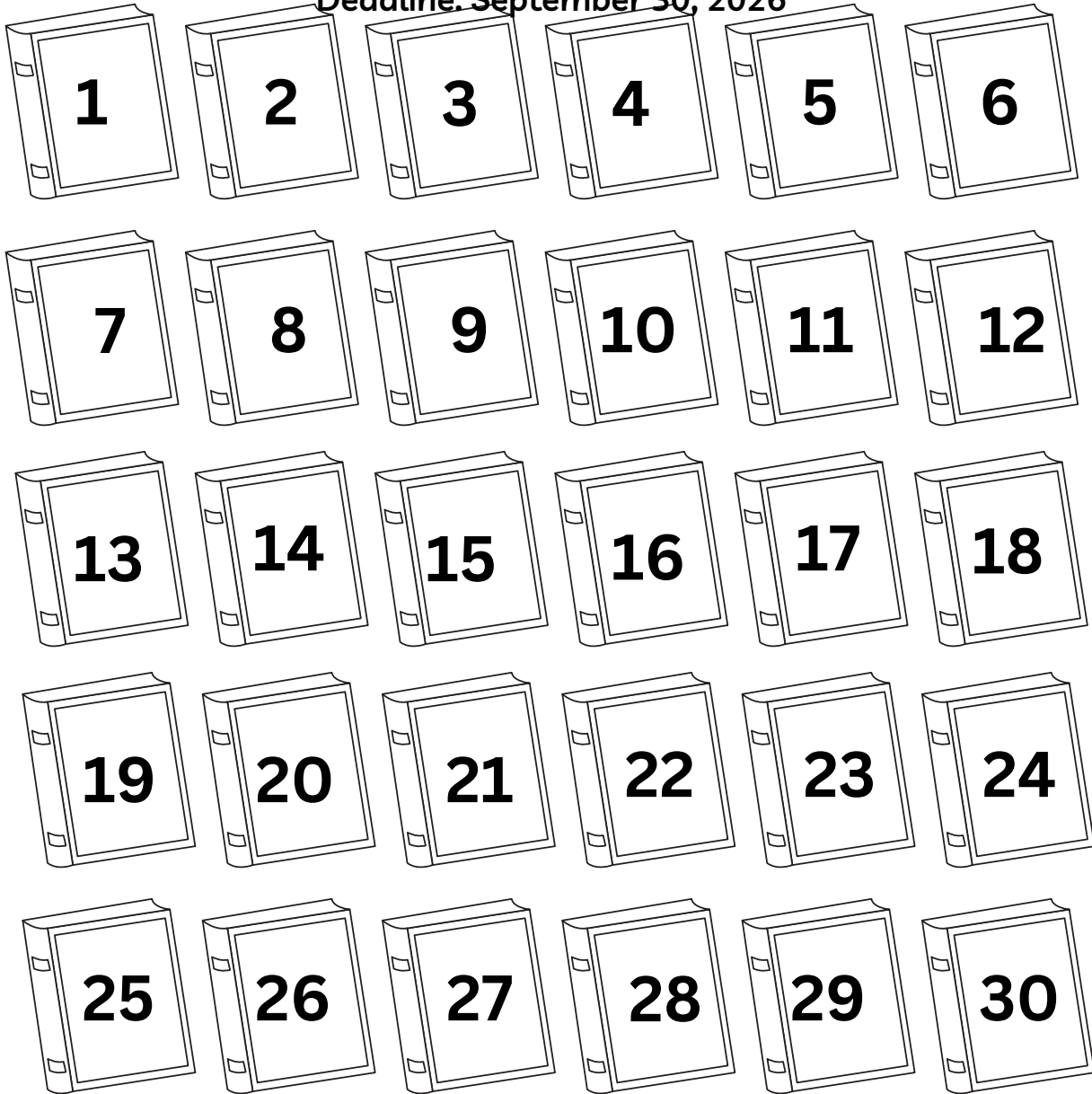

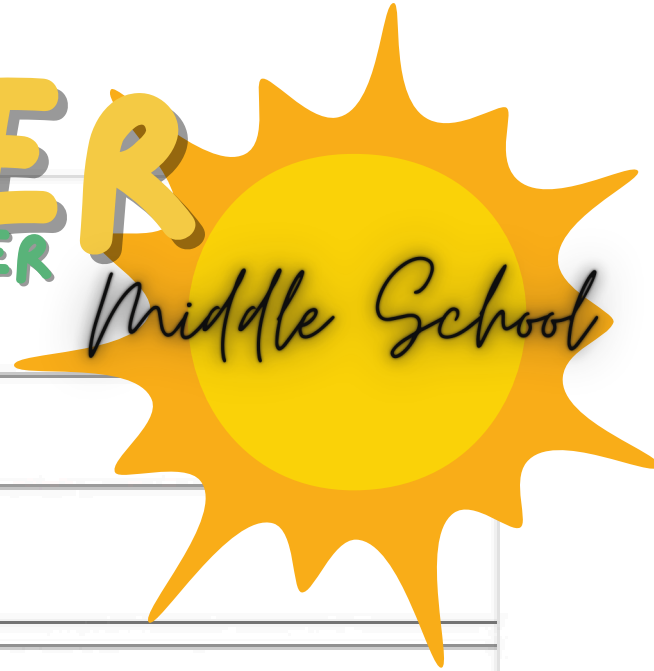
